

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes our privacy practices, the personal information we collect, how we use and share it, as well as your rights and choices regarding this information. This Privacy Policy applies to personal information of applicants, students, teachers, mentors and volunteers (“**you**” or “**your**”) of the inVisionU program (“**Program**”) operated by Private Charitable Foundation ‘Spark Programs’, BIN 220740042362 (“**we**” or “**us**”).

What information we collect

For applicants and students:

- Application and contact information;
- Academic Interest;
- Academic performance;
- Feedback from teachers and mentors;
- Family income certificates and bank details for providing scholarship programs;
- Photo and video materials;
- Any additional information provided by you;
- Information in correspondence: information you send to us, which may include chat messages, emails, and phone calls you make to us.

For teachers, mentors and volunteers:

- Contact information;
- Work experience and motivation;
- Feedback on students;
- Photo and video materials;
- Any additional information provided by you.

How we use your information

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- To process and review your application;
- To organize the activities of the Program;
- To provide scholarships;
- To communicate with you regarding your application and future opportunities;
- To improve our programs, website, and user experience;
- To send you updates, newsletters, and marketing communications;
- To promote the Program;

- To protect rights and comply with legal requirements.

How we share your information

With service providers: We may share your information with our service providers (e.g., accountants, consultants, software providers, travel agency) in order to carry out processes on our behalf or as a partner, or to support our Program functions.

With partners: We may share your information with our partners and other entities outside of your country of residence. These partners and entities support us in implementing the Program and may assist in various aspects such as Program delivery, implementation, review, research, or operational support. We transfer your personal information in accordance with applicable laws and take steps to ensure that your information is appropriately protected.

For marketing: We may cooperate with third-party marketing platforms and service providers to assist us and perform certain marketing services for us. We may also disclose personal information to share the results of the Program or upcoming events on:

- our website (www.invisionu.edu)
- social media channels and digital communications media such as podcasts;
- presentations, exhibition materials, booklets and brochures;
- news media and their associated websites, print publications, television and radio.

For legal reasons: We may disclose your personal information when it is necessary to comply with legal requirements or to protect the rights.

Cookie files

Our website uses cookies to enhance your browsing experience and provide personalized services. Cookies are small data files stored on your device that help us track user interactions, save preferences, and improve our services.

You can manage your cookie preferences by adjusting your browser settings or using our cookie management tool available on our website.

Your rights and choices

Accessing, amending or deleting your data. You may access, amend or delete your personal information that we hold by contacting us at the email indicated at the end of this Privacy Policy.

Restriction of processing. You may require us to block the processing of personal data in the case of violation of the condition of collection, and/or processing of personal data.

Withdrawing consent. You have the right to withdraw your consent to the collection or processing of personal data and to withdraw consent to the distribution of personal data in publicly available sources of personal data.

Unsubscribing from emails. You can opt out of email messages by using the “unsubscribe” link or mechanism noted in such emails.

Asking us questions or raising a complaint. We will be happy to answer any questions you may have about this Privacy Policy or about how we treat your information. We will respond to your request consistent with applicable law and subject to proper verification of your identity. If you wish to raise a concern about our use of your information, you have the right to complain to your local supervisory authority.

How we store your information

We retain your information for as long as necessary to achieve the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. Particularly, we may also need to retain some of your information after the completion of the Program to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.
